TRANSPORT OPTIONS

Lake Ainsworth Sport & Recreation Centre is at the northern end of Lennox Head, mid-way between Byron Bay and Ballina.

Flying Ballina airport is the closest (15min driving), other accessible airports are Coolangatta/Goldcoast (2hrs approx. via shuttle) & Brisbane.

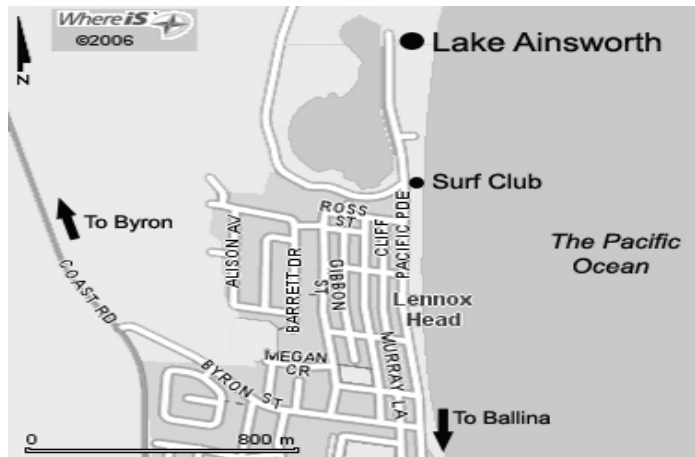
Bus Lennox Head is a designated Countrylink coach travel stop

Driving to Lake Ainsworth (heading north)

Follow the Pacific Highway through to Ballina. Follow the signs through Ballina to Lennox Head. Continue through the Lennox Head township on Pacific Parade past the Surf Club. The centre is on Pacific Parade on the northern end of Lake Ainsworth.

Driving to Lake Ainsworth (heading south)

Follow the Pacific Highway through to the Lennox Head turn off (Ross Lane, south of Knockrow). Turn right at the first "T" intersection. Turn left into the Lennox Head township. Turn left again at the "T" intersection at the ocean & follow Pacific Parade north past the surf club to the northern end of Lake Ainsworth.

At **acic10** participants will be able to deepen their experience of CI, with the opportunity to choose from an array of classes and workshops lead by some of Australia's most experienced CI practitioners, as well as the time and space for self-directed inquiry, shared investigations and just plenty of dancing! Many of the popular activities from previous ACICs will return, like the performance night. The convergence continues to support, enrich and celebrate our CI culture in Australia and beyond, for individuals and communities alike.

Lake Ainsworth Sport and Recreation Centre is nestled metres from Seven Mile Beach as well as bordering a tea-tree freshwater lake. Dance on the sprung timber floor of the stadium hall, amongst the trees, on the beach, or in the water! Residential participants stay in comfortable dormitory accommodation with ensuite bathrooms, and continental breakfast provided each morning beside the beach.

Lunch and dinner are delicious mostly-organic, vegetarian cuisine, cooked onsite. Meal times take place beside the beach and under the stars; perfect fuel for 5 days of dancing and getting to know your dance partners!

Contact Improvisation (CI) is a highly enjoyable dance form where partners improvise their movement around a shared point of contact. It involves the dynamic interplay of natural forces, such as gravity and momentum, with the communicative ability of touch and contact. CI is danced all over the world by people from all walks of life and levels of experience.
